CNSVS - Testing (Computerized Neurocognitive Status Vital Signs)

Neurocognitive testing assesses a patient's memory, mental speed and other cognitive functions (ex: learning, remembering, concentration, solving problems and making decisions). It evaluates the health of your brains function and activity when it is under challenge.

- 1. You will take a simple computer based assessment called CNS Vital Signs. You DO NOT need computer experience or computer skills to take the assessment. You will only use a few keys on the keyboard to record your responses.
- 2. Testing will take approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour. A one hour appointment is blocked for the appointment. Please be on time, if you are 15 minutes late your appointment will be rescheduled.
- 3. Family members, children or friends will not be allowed in the room with patient during testing. Please do not bring children to your appointment unless you have someone with you to watch them.
- 4. If you wear glasses or hearing aids make sure you are wearing them. If you forget them testing may have to be rescheduled.
- 5. Depending on your ordering physicians instructions your test results will be reviewed at your next follow up appointment.
